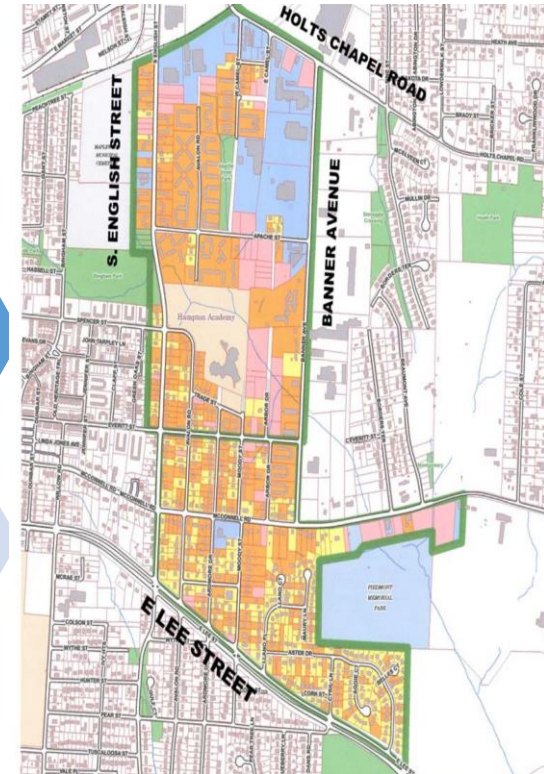


Cottage Grove: Community-Centered Health
